Sara gained recognition in the mid 80's, 90's to mid 2000 with her magical trompe l'oeil mural commissions in California, Ontario, Nova Scotia, British Columbia, and Florida. When time allowed, she did studio painting and worked at her other passion, interior design, receiving a renovations award in a national interior design competition.

Never content with repetition, she continues to experiment with different effects, techniques, and design, consequently reflecting her evolving style.

Sara's paintings frequently demonstrate her sharp observations of the human condition. Whether it is in the joy of music, the grueling manual labour required in the production of wine, or homage paid to the Impressionists for their portrayal of everyday people, her paintings urge us to view these subjects with new eyes and appreciation. Even in her still life paintings there are messages to uncover.

Over the years, Sara's work has been featured in a California Lifestyle magazine, the Globe and Mail, Canadian House & Home, Country Life and Lifestyle Nova Scotia. Two of her trompe l'oeil panels hang in the Hospital for Sick Kids and a Ronald MacDonald House in Toronto.
